## Golf Outing a Success

This year with the Queen of Peace Council of Closter, 74 participants began their quest to win \$10,000, a 2018 Ford Mustang, airfare for two in the continental US, a big screen TV, a set of Callaway golf clubs, or a \$1000 shopping spree at the PGA Tour Super Store if they managed to get a hole in one. The prizes are safe since no one was lucky or skilled enough to accomplish this extraordinary feat.

The course was in great condition, the greens were fast, and the weather was terrific for a day on the links. The winning score was a 62, which is 10 below par for the course. Prizes were awarded for the closest to the pin on all four par 3 holes, along with the longest and straightest drives and lowest net score.

There were many new participants in this year's outing including a women's foursome and our oldest player to date, a 91-year-old former wrestling coach from Leonia HS – Phil Klocik. Our hole sponsors number was the same as last year, 42, with 13 new additions to the outing.

When the final tally is done, we will have achieved our goal of raising just over \$5000 for the Funds. This means that the Scholarships we provide will be able to continue for the foreseeable future.

This event is very labor intense and time consuming. Without the help of a very select few members who stepped up when asked, we would not be able to continue to host this outing. Whether they solicited gifts from local businesses, asked for hole sponsorships, donated gifts, or money, assisted at registration, or sat at a hole to be a witness to a hole in one their contributions are commendable and very much appreciated.

So, special thanks to Joe Bisi, Frank Mariconti, Jim Abrams, Bill Filon, John Marzulla, and Gus Molina. Thanks also to Orlando Setola for volunteering his father-in-law to sit at a hole. But the biggest thank you is reserved for Tom Diadone and to his wife, Annie, for their generous donation of the luncheon at the Florentine Gardens and to All American Ford for providing the Mustang as a prize.

Planning for next year's event is already underway and the hope is to make it bigger and better. It is not too early for you to begin thinking about getting involved and helping with this fund-raiser. It is your Council and the Scholarships are presented in your name, so why not be part of the picture next year.




