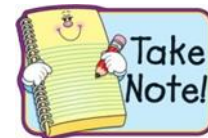


During May Brother Knights performed the following volunteer activities:

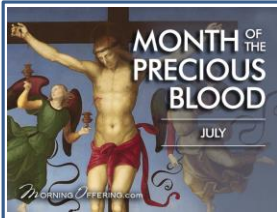

MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD



The month of July traditionally honors the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. It is the blood of Christ, the Lamb of God, which cleanses from sin, therefore the Church developed a devotion to Jesus' physical blood and its mystical power, just as it did for his Sacred Heart from which his blood poured out on the Cross. The Precious Blood of Jesus courses through the Church spiritually, giving eternal life to the Body of Christ through the sacraments. Many saints had a devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus, most notably St. Catherine of Siena. Devotion to the Precious Blood spread greatly through the preaching of Saint Gaspar del Bufalo, a 19th century priest and founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood, and was later approved and recommended by the Holy See. The feast day of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus is July 1st.

If we are honest, we know that we are not good at "coming away ... to a deserted place" to "rest a while." In fact 80% of us check out smart phones even before brushing our teeth in the morning and spend time on them in the last hour before we go to sleep. Like the apostles, we focus on getting a lot done. But let's imagine what would happen if we truly responded to the challenge of Jesus to "come away" to pray in solitude every morning, resting in His presence and Holy Word. Jesus invite us to put fist things first. Let's take him at his word and make the changes we need to make.

YOUR GOAL FOR JULY

This month, the Supreme Chaplain challenges us to "come away" to a quiet place by praying at least five minutes a day, first thing in the morning before you check you electronic device or turn on the TV. You will likely have stops and starts, but strive to be as consistent as possible. In addition, the Supreme Chaplain challenges you to respond to Jesus' invitation to "rest a while" by doing something truly restful on Sunday, the day of rest.

First, **ALL** volunteers **MUST** complete the training, whether you are in a Mass ministry or volunteer in any capacity in any parish. Second, the training must be renewed every FIVE years. The training can now be completed either at a class or individually ONLINE. And, it is completely FREE! 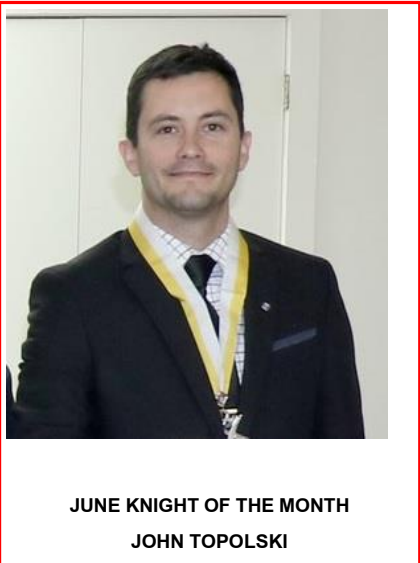
