- Vince Vogelgesang - gave the treasurer report. He mentioned that the next installment donation for the Special Olympics will be made.

- We discussed the Walter Batz Family Activity. Decided to postpone till later.

- Jim Chappuis - gave the financial secretary report of receipts and expenses.

- Joe Strange - brought up that MOPS has had to hire sitters to watch the children during the 8:30 a.m. and 10:15 a.m. Masses. We discussed giving the a large donation as advertising to get some of those fathers to join the Knights. Joe mentioned we have substantial funds in our account and should be giving it away. Later Dave Denzer stressed that idea.

- We voted to give the May Bingo 50/50 funds and Tips to them and match the proceeds up to \$500.

- Rich Lacaille - We have an application for K of C scholarship funds. The family's adjusted income is \$134,000, so we decided to have them approach the parish's Holy Infant Tuition Assistance program.

- Tom Tracy - Script sales profits are down 25% from last year. 2016 vs 2015 profits were about \$6,000 vs \$8,000..

- We discussed whether it is worth continuing with the program due to all the work Tom has to do. \$6K is about \$500 per month, which is about Bingo's 50/50 and Tip money.

- Tom is supposed to sell script in the cafeteria Thursday, 5/11, from 7 - 9 a.m. but needs help because he can't be there this week.

- Fred Lagos - Ron Harmon asked if we could give some script cards to Kennedy High School for their senior lock-in. These would be prizes. We voted to give 10 \$10 cards for a total of \$100.

- Steve Lane - talked about a program given out to attendees of KofC awards program for school kids at St. Clare of Assisi.
