GOLF TOURNAMENT MAY 7

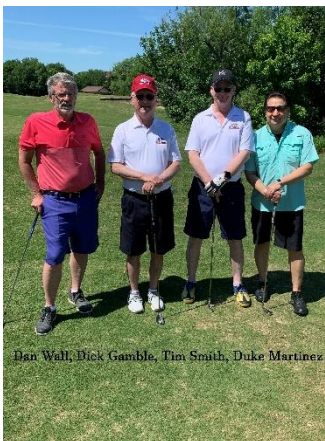

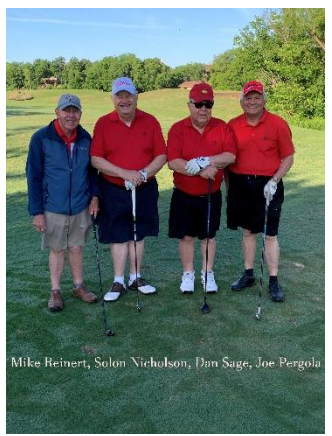
