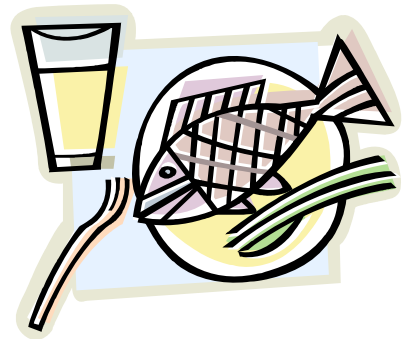
LADIES APPRECIATION LUNCHEON

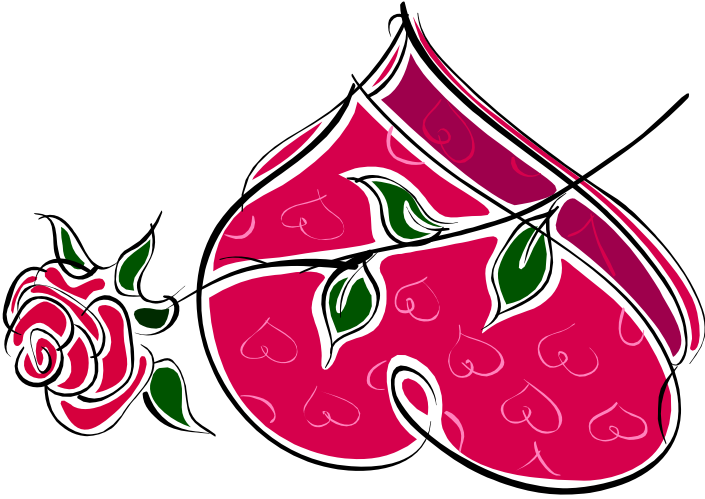
7 – Fish Fry – Remember it's Lent so don't cook fish let us do it for you.
