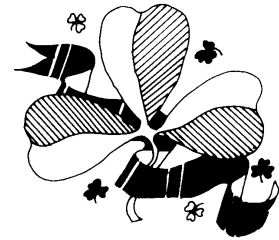

The Flea Market was very successful. We made a profit of almost \$1200. Thanks to all who helped make this a success.

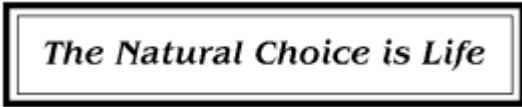
Youth (Andy Lehman)
