May 9 is Ladies Appreciation Night – we need reservations by April 18 – not the 25<sup>th</sup>. You pay for your ticket – your Lady's is free.


Komen Race for the Cure for S. Arizona is April 14. Evelyn Hennelly will walk. The Council elected to donate \$100 in sponsorship to the cause.
