years and experience in other offices and program activities before advancing to the position of Grand Knight. So we celebrate with these brothers and recognize their many years of hard work and devotion.

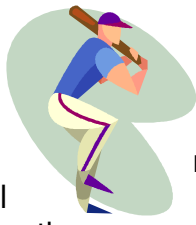
Second/ Third Degrees at Regina Cleri

The nominating committee has prepared the following slate of candidates – but additional nominations may be made at the meeting for any of these positions.

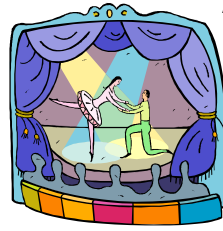
