12) Find out your doctor's position on abortion. If he/she does abortions, express your disapproval by switching to a pro-life doctor. If a hospital near you does abortions, express your diapproval and use another hospital. Provide your doctor with pro-life literature.

13) Find out who the local abortionists are. Some of them do it "on the side". Let them know your opposition to abortion. Pray for them by name.
