The Knights of Columbus Supreme Council has started the Knights of Columbus Heroes Fund to honor the police, firemen, and emergency medical technicians and other rescue workers killed in their rescue attempts in New York and Washington, D.C. “Families of law enforcement officers, firefighters and emergency medical technicians who have died or may yet lose their lives in rescue efforts at the World Trade Center and Pentagon will receive grants of \$3,000 from the Knights, “, says Supreme Knight Carl Anderson. 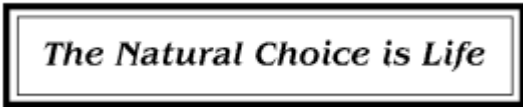
PUBLIC RELATIONS
