- Councils should forward this downloadable PDF invitation to all eligible prospects for admission and advancement (click here for [English](#), [Spanish](#), [French](#)).
- Instruct the candidates to register for the exemplification of their choice by clicking on its associated link within the PDF invitation and filling out the online form. Note you will need our council number (2117) to complete the registration.
- Candidates then participate in the scheduled ceremony.
- After the ceremony, councils must process new candidates by submitting form 100s the traditional way or electronically in Officers Online.
