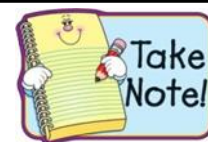


### During August Brother Knights performed the following volunteer activities:

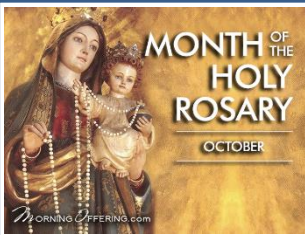

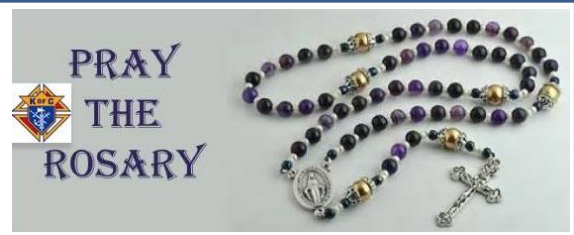

## **VIRTUS<sup>®</sup> Online ABUSE AWARENESS INFORMATION**

The Archdiocese of Santa Fe recently changed policy regarding the abuse awareness training for the protection of children. First, **ALL** volunteers **MUST** complete the training, whether you are in a Mass ministry or volunteer in any capacity in any parish. Second, the training must be renewed every FIVE years. The training can now be completed either at a class or individually ONLINE. And, it is completely FREE!
