The 2020 Thomas Wayne Finto Scholarship will be awarded by the Knights of Columbus Alamo Council 4298 in a competitive process that may consider: volunteer commitment, charitable activities, church involvement, attendance at Saint Pius X Catholic School San Antonio, Student or family membership in the Knights of Columbus, academic achievement, personal statement of what the student has learned by participation in charitable activities and how has this prepared them for additional education opportunities. Scholarship is renewable for up to four (4) years and if recipient maintains qualifying renewal-specific criteria. This scholarship will reimburse student for paid tuition, books, fees, supplies and equipment required for any full time course load at colleges, universities or technical schools.

Scholarship

The Thomas Wayne Finto Scholarship provides a new or renewal scholarship at \$500.00 per year for up to four years to attend a school of learning full time beyond High School.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for a new scholarship award, all students must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a 2020 graduate of High School**
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher**
- Be a United States Citizen or lawful permanent resident**
- Must be planning to enroll as a full time first year student in a school of higher learning**
- Demonstrated a volunteer commitment for charitable endeavors**
- Completed and submitted application materials by the postmarked deadline date**
