Returning Volunteers

The Diocese has moved to a new Safe Environment platform. Please follow the steps below to access your Virtus profile:

1. Go to www.virtus.org.
2. Enter the email address you previously used on the old Safe Environment platform.
3. Select "I need login help" and follow the prompts to reset your password.

***Note:** You may see a message that says, "not compliant," even if your account is up to date. The Diocese is currently working to resolve this issue.*

Once you are logged in, please complete the online training video assigned and submit any required forms. Please also update any personal information, address, background check form, cell, etc. **Be sure to send an email to Cecy Tanaka at ctanaka@sacredheartrowlett.org when you complete the course.**

The Screening Form is only filled out in Year 1.

Reference Checks are only conducted in Year 1

The Personal Interview is only conducted in Year 1.

Criminal History Re-Check - If you are up to date on your annual training, the re-check will be conducted automatically every two years.

The database will notify the Sacred Heart SE officer when you complete the training, but please email a copy of your certificate to Johnny for the KC council files. Also keep a copy for your records.

After all steps have been completed, please allow at least 7 days for the processing and distribution of your badge. Cecy will contact you to let you know that your badge can be picked up at the Sacred Heart office.

The badge must always be worn when on church grounds other than when attending mass. If you are cleared and need a new badge, call Cecy at Ext. 108

Your badge will indicate your expiration date and next training date due.
