On the First Day of Christmas

"On the first day of Christmas, my True Love gave to me... a partridge in a pear tree."

Remember that famous Christmas song, The Twelve Days of Christmas? The song's melody that we sing today was given shape in 1909 by English composer Frederic Austin. The earliest known version of the song's lyrics are found in a 1780s British children's book, Mirth Without Mischief.

Twenty-three years ago, in October 1998, my wife and I moved into a new home in Streamwood. There was one tree in the front yard and none in the back yard. The following Spring, I bought two trees from Home Depot—a red maple tree and a pear tree. I planted them in the two corners of my

backyard. Both trees were about four feet high. Today, our maple tree is about 15 feet high, and our pear tree is about 40 feet tall. When I look out the windows to the backyard, I'm amazed at how tall that pear tree has grown since I planted it.

The Twelve Days of Christmas starts with one gift on Christmas Day and adds another each day for the next eleven days. When you sing the song, each new verse also recalls every one of the previous gifts. Each verse ends with "...and a partridge in a pear tree."

There have been numerous interpretations of what those gifts mean, including religious themes. The theme I like the most describes the partridge in the pear tree as the baby Jesus, roosting with His mother Mary at the very first Christmas, the Nativity of Our Lord. God is our True Love, who gave us His Son Jesus–on the first day of the very first Christmas.

We celebrate God our Father's True Love every Christmas. And like Father, like Son: Jesus gives Himself, His Life and Love, to us in every Eucharist that we celebrate.

For this year's First Day of Christmas, who are the true loves you will gifts to in your life?

How will your true loves grow bigger, taller, and more amazing each year

through your generous planting of God's love?

Yes, your true loves will grow because You are the Good of the Order, truly loved by God who plants the good seeds of His Word and works His good deeds—in and through you.


