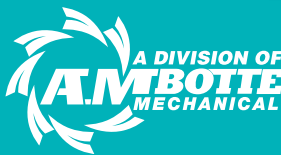

Grand Knight's Message

The Holy Jubilee Year of 2025 presents an opportunity for spiritual renewal and introspection. One way to do that is to make a pilgrimage, which emphasizes the inner journey, rather than the destination.

This year, I took two pilgrimages visiting the Vatican with my family and walking "The Camino" through Northern Spain. Walking through the Holy Doors of Rome's four main basilicas was awe-inspiring, especially with my family. "The Camino" provided space for reflection as I walked on foot, considering life along "The Way." I highly recommend the movie of that name, with Martin Sheen and Emilio Estevez.

Pilgrimages also can include visits to ancestral homes, as I discovered in January 2023, when I traveled with my father to his birthplace in Karkala, India. We visited his childhood school, shared family stories, and attended the Basilica of Saint Lawrence's festival. Lighting candles in memory of deceased relatives was a deeply spiritual experience, made even more meaningful with my 90-year-old father.

Reflecting on this journey, I realized the importance of seizing opportunities. My father, once vibrant but now limited by health, shared that he had the means to travel in his youth but lacked the funds. Now, with the means but not the mobility, our trip to India was likely his last overseas journey. This experience underscores the wisdom of Steven de Grellet's quote: "I expect to pass through this world but once. Any good, therefore, that I can do or any kindness I can show to any fellow creature, let me do it now."

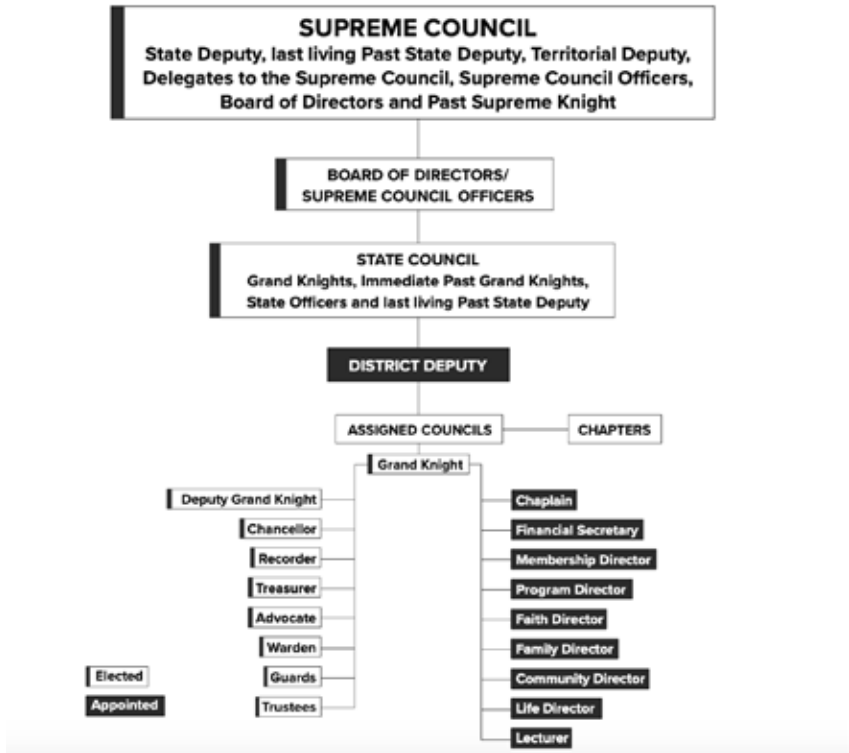

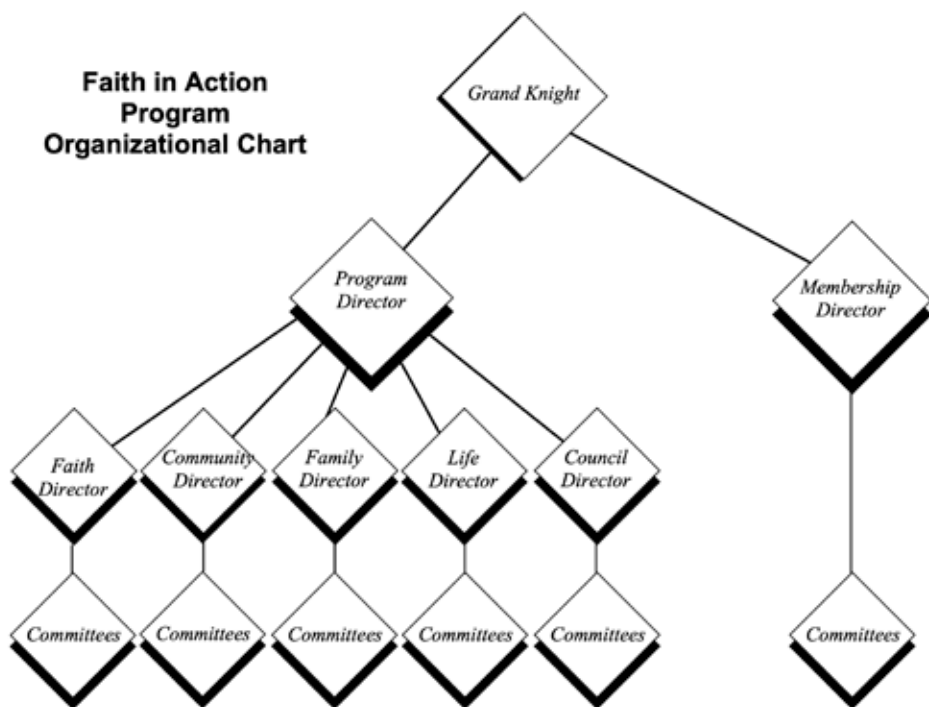

Who are the Knights?

Blessed Father Michael McGivney began the Knights of Columbus in 1882, and it now has 2 million members and 15,000 local councils. The Santa Maria Council has nearly 475 members from St. Joseph the Worker, St. Rose of Lima, and St. Teresa of Calcutta parishes. Our Council supports:

- Scholarships for students to attend local Catholic high schools;
- Food baskets at Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter for families in need;
- An annual appreciation luncheon for religious sisters, as well as a police appreciation dinner;
- Support for the March for Life and grants to local centers for Aid and Support after Pregnancy;
- Poster contests, spelling bees, and free-throw contests for children;
- Support coin-tosses for those with intellectual disabilities, Alzheimer's, and Multiple Sclerosis.

We are also men of faith. We pray in Nocturnal Adorations and Rosaries in parish churches and at the shrine to Our Queen of the Knights in front of our Council home. We support brothers and families in need with weekly prayers.

Santa Maria Council was founded in 1909 in Haddon Heights, NJ. The current council home at 350 W Crystal Lake Avenue in Haddon Township, was dedicated on Sunday, September 11, 1955. Regular Council Meetings take place on the first and third Monday of the month.

The Charity, Unity, Fraternity Degree, which welcomes new members to our Council, is held at Santa Maria several times throughout the year and at other nearby councils throughout the year. The Degree emphasizes the principles of Charity, Unity, and Fraternity and is used to initiate new members into our Order.

A 4th Degree Exemplification on Patriotism is usually held in November at an offsite location. Santa Maria Council members who hold the 4th degree are affiliated with Bishop Eustace Assembly #652.
