News from CKC

As most of you know Covid-19 affected the rental demand for the Knights Hall for the last three years. During these three years CKC exhausted all the bank CD funds and needed an additional \$20,000 from the Council funds to keep the lights on. Rentals have been picking up as of late, but we are just keeping up with the bills at this point. Right now, CKC has about \$16,000 in the bank for emergency funds. We anticipated this financial situation about a year ago, and we put the vacant lot to the west of the hall up for sale. The land is currently listed for \$225,000 and it last appraised at \$185,000. Currently, we have had very little interest in the land, but we have a standing offer of \$160,000 from our real estate agent, Paul Land. Earlier this year we were also approached by the Eagles organization to purchase the Knights Hall and parking lot. After hearing this, CKC decided to have the building appraised again because it had been over 15 years since the appraisal was done on the building itself. The building and parking lot appraised at \$1,066,580 and the lot appraisal was \$185,000 for a total of \$1,251,580. The first offer the Eagles gave us was \$600,000 for the building and parking lot area. This offer was rejected and come to find out there were only willing to go as high as \$800,000. CKC feels that this offer isn't enough to warrant selling the building at that price. I just want to make sure that everyone knows that a selling the building and property, must be approved by the full membership of CKC, with includes all members of the Knights of Columbus Council #1529. With no unexpected major repairs in the near future, we should be ok, but we are not able to financially handle one large AC unit (\$45,000) going out. Please look for a survey that will be sent out soon by CKC to help determine the future of the Knights Hall and vacant lot. We are waiting for the results of the upcoming survey to move forward.
