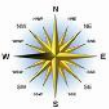

Chaplain's Reflection

Toward the end of his Gospel, St. John recalls an encounter between the Risen Christ and Saint Peter by the Sea of Tiberias. Jesus asks Peter three times if he loves him. Biblical commentators signal a curious wordplay in the conversation. Whereas the evangelist inserts the Greek word "agape" (or unconditional love) in Jesus' first two questions, "Do you love me?", he uses the Greek word "philia" (or love of friendship) in Peter's responses, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you" (Jn 21:15-16). Only in the third interlocution does John use the Greek word philia for both Jesus' question and Peter's reply. The late Benedict XVI opined that Peter's inability to commit to the all-encompassing and self-sacrificial love exemplified by Jesus stems from the "drama of Peter's own weakness," since he betrayed his Master just days prior (cf. Benedict XVI, General Audience, 24 May 2006). As much as that shocks the reader, it also provides a familiar lens into the human condition. Fickle is the human heart. In many ways, the ambient culture obsesses over a limited version of love, and



leaves no room for the kinds of distinctions present in John's Gospel. God designed the human heart for the capacity to love eternally and unconditionally (agape) – evidenced in the tears of every creature who mourns the loss of another. Yet, society so often reduces love to physical affection alone (what the Greeks called "eros"). Lawn-signs now proudly tout a vapid tautology — "love is love" — without ever uncovering its riches. Biblical wisdom provides a more ancient worldview, however: "Deep waters cannot quench love, nor rivers sweep it away" (Song of Songs 8:7). This should bring consolation to every human heart. Man does not receive his identity from his physical desires – let alone from his sins. Rather, man understands his deepest self as one created by

As Council leaders and brother Knights, we are driven by a desire to serve. We wholeheartedly believe that we need to demonstrate our faith through service. Faith in action is a model that drives all that we do. We seek to balance all of our activities in four key areas **Faith, Family, Community, and Life**. Here are our proposed investments in each of these categories for this year.

Faith

- **Seminarian Support:** We will continue to fund 6 seminarians with \$1,500 per year for a total of \$9,000.

- **Council Memorial Mass:** Memorial mass celebrated in November in honor of our most recent Knight's passing.
- **Franciscan Support:** Continue to financially support the Conventual Franciscans of California (in the name of Father Peter Mallin, our spiritual guide and Chaplin).

Family

Our goal in Family is to strengthen the bonds of the children and parents to our Catholic faith.

- **Food for Families:** We will donate \$1,500 to the South Bay Outreach Center (House of Yahweh) and \$500 to the Saint Lawrence Food Pantry.
- **Family of the Month:** Continuously recognized, promote and support the development of strong and vibrant families in the faith.
- **Family Fully Alive:** Promote a program for families to invite God into their homes and cultivate each family as a miniature domestic church.
- **Other Family-related activities:** Donate \$650 to SLM Get

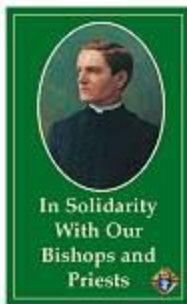

- **Global Wheelchair:** Donation of \$1,500 that will provide 10 brand new wheelchairs into the life of a child, teen, or adult in desperate need of mobility.
- **Habitat for Humanity:** Donation of \$1,000 to help with providing housing to low-income families and individuals, and will try to get more directly involved with them on projects this year.
- **Community Donations:** Donation of \$1,000 to Rancho San Antonio and \$250 to Fellowship of Catholic University Students.
- **Helping Hands:** Continue to support our 3 parishes with various activities including the SJF Summer Concert cook-off (July 15), SJ and SLM Coffee & Donuts, SJ Harvest Festival (November 3-5), SJ Nativity/Xmas Tree set-up/teardown, and much more.

Life

Our goal in Life is to defend the dignity of each human being at every stage of life.

- **Special Olympics:** Donation of \$2,000 to the Special Olympics program to assist with feeding the athletes, provisioning equipment, and awards.
- **Pregnancy Help Center:** Donation of \$1,000 to the Torrance Pregnancy Center to support their operations.
- **Star House:** Fundraiser with Tootsie Rolls in support of the Star House in the South Bay that provides intellectually and developmentally disabled the freedom of choice with respect to housing, employment, and recreational activities.
