2025 Scholarship Program Results

The 6th Annual Knights of Columbus Kirkwood Council 2117 8th Grade Graduate Scholarship Program wrapped up with final submission due on April 21.

In total, 34 students participated, marking the second largest pool of applicants in the program's history. The pool of candidates was comprised of 24 St Peter students (including 1 PSR student) and 10 St Gerard Majella students.

David Anderson, Tom Foy, Keith Beardslee and Scholarship Chairman **Dan Koskovich** served as judges, reading the submissions of all 34 candidates. With a package that included Hopes and Goals, Extra Curricular Activities, and two essay questions, this was a time-consuming yet rewarding exercise...thank you to our judges!



When all the final score sheets were tallied \$1,000 scholarships were awarded to 7 St Peter students and 3 St Gerard Majella students made up of 7 girls and 3 boys moving on to 6 different Catholic high schools: Cor Jesu, St Joseph Academy, Ursuline, Chaminade, DeSmet, and SLUH. The awards and checks will be given to the students at their school's graduation awards ceremonies in the next few weeks.

We have already received thanks from the principals of both parish schools and the program was well supported by both.

Thank you to everyone whose efforts throughout the year make it possible for us provide the wonderful program and best wishes to the elementary schools Class of 2025!
