

OFFICIAL NEW 50/50 RULES
To Benefit
Knights of Columbus Council 2191
Batavia, IL. 60510

1. Raffle Ticket: \$100 each – Maximum of 500 tickets will be sold.
2. Drawing to be held on Tuesday, February 4th, 2025 at Knights of Columbus Hall in Batavia, IL.
3. Knights of Columbus will award up to \$25,000 to the Grand Prize winner if all 500 tickets are sold. \$1000 to the 2nd place winner and \$500 to the 3rd place winner.
4. Winner is entirely and solely responsible for all taxes associated with the winnings.
5. If at least 450 raffle tickets are not sold by February 4th, Knights of Columbus reserves the right to extend the drawing until at least 450 tickets are sold. The Grand Prize winner will win half of the total sales from the tickets. Example: 450 tickets are sold for total sale of \$45,000 then Grand prize winner will receive \$22,500.
6. **Winner need not be present at drawing to win.**
7. By submitting an entry, each purchaser acknowledges having read, and agrees to abide by these Official Raffle Rules.
8. *Each purchaser of a raffle ticket must be at least 18 years old*, and only one individual's name may be associated with each ticket. All federal, state and local rules shall apply to the raffle. Tickets may be purchased on-line at www.kc2191.org, by check in person, or by mail to Knights of Columbus ... PO Box 25 Batavia, IL. 60510. Payments for online tickets may only be by credit card. Any credit card payment that is denied shall disqualify the pending purchase and any ticket issued for such purchase will be forfeited by the purchaser. All e-mail communications will be sent to the e-mail address provided by the purchaser as part of the purchase. Such communications shall include purchase confirmation and raffle ticket number. Purchaser is required to provide the Knights of Columbus ("Raffle Sponsor") a valid, functioning e-mail address and mailing address. The Raffle Sponsor, its processing agent and their respective directors, officers, and members assume no responsibility for incorrect, invalid, terminated or non-functioning e-mail or mailing addresses or lost, incomplete, late, illegible, or undelivered entries or entries without complete, acceptable payment.
9. Once a ticket has been purchased, it is non-refundable except in the event the raffle is cancelled. Odds of winning depend on the number of tickets sold. The maximum number of tickets to be sold is 500.
10. Each ticket shall be sequentially numbered from the first ticket sold through the last ticket number sold. The raffle period shall be from the date the first ticket is sold, through Monday Feb 3rd 2025, or such earlier date as the maximum number of tickets is sold. Online ticket sales may be closed at any time before the drawing. The drawing will be held on Tuesday, February 4th 2025. Ticket purchase deadlines, and drawing dates, times and locations, may be extended or changed at the Raffle Sponsor's discretion.
11. There will be a maximum of 500 tickets sold, however the Knights of Columbus maintain the right to print Secondary tickets to cover for missing or lost tickets that occur within distribution of tickets.
12. Each online purchaser will be sent a ticket receipt via e-mail or mail. The original printed raffle ticket will be retained by the Raffle Sponsor and the stub entered into the drawing along with the stubs of all other tickets sold. U.S. Postal regulations prohibit the mailing of raffle tickets.
13. The holders of the winning ticket shall be notified by telephone and/or e-mail and Certified U.S. Mail at the address provided by the purchaser. The winning ticket number and name of the winner and their respective cities (but not addresses) shall also be placed on the Raffle web site immediately after the drawing. This information may also be publicized in other media.
14. The winner of the drawing shall be required to provide the Raffle Sponsor with a signed statement confirming their eligibility under these Rules and applicable law, proof of age and social security number, and a release confirming the Raffle Sponsor's permission to use the winner's name, city, state, and likeness in media releases and other publicity.
15. Winner will be entirely and solely responsible for paying any applicable federal and state income taxes. Please consult with your own tax advisor.
16. The prize will be awarded "as is".
17. Purchasers of tickets, by participating in the raffle, release the Raffle Sponsor, its directors, officers, members and agents from any and all liability, loss or claim arising out of any raffle prize, expressly waive any such claim and agree that the liability, if any, of the Raffle Sponsor, its directors, officers, members and agents shall be limited to the raffle ticket price paid. In case of any dispute regarding the conduct of the raffle, the decision of the Raffle Sponsor shall be final.
