Life Savers for Life

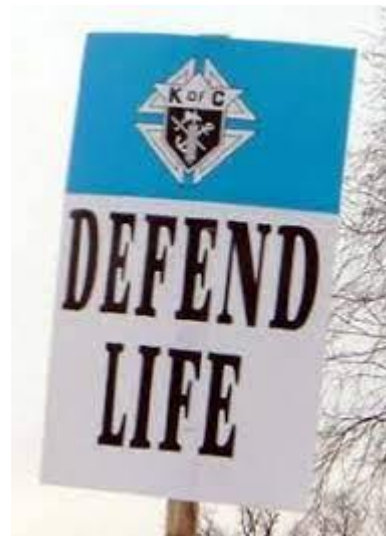
