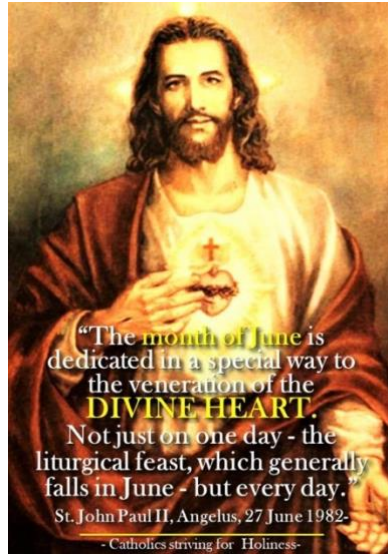

Hello my brother knights,

Greetings from Houston. I have been enjoying a celebration for the Priests of the Sacred Heart, as well as the Church with an SCJ Priesthood Ordination here in Texas.
