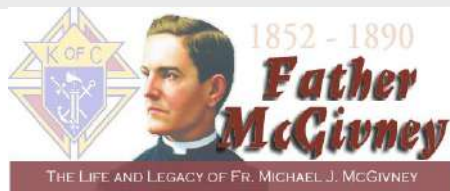

Sir Knight Brother Frank Vince passed away on March 5, 2026, at the age of 98. Born on March 15, 1927, Frank was a resident of Banning, California.



Born in Kunagota, Hungary the 3rd youngest to a family of 10. At 16 he left his small hometown for the big city of Budapest. Escaped when he was 20 and made it to Canada in the Spring of 1949. He met the one and only true love of his life, Theresa in Canada in December of 1955. Proposed on his birthday March of 1956. They then married in July 1956 and moved to California in 1957. He

worked in the restaurant business until he retired at age 62. He served 2 presidents in his 32 years as a waiter, captain, and maitre'd. in the end he became a banquet manager. God was with him the whole way. His family, faith, and the Holy Eucharist led him through hunger, nakedness, and homelessness with Thanksgiving for his blessed life here on earth and to his Eternal home in the arms of Our Lord.

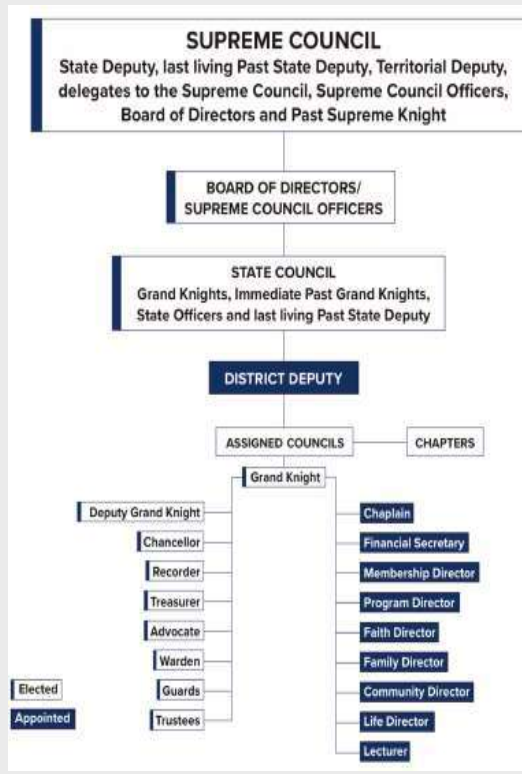

Grand Knight Report: G.K. Benson

1. FISH FRY current numbers as of April 7: 1,487 dinners paid; gross \$22,314; net \$11,759 (before Parish donation); approx. 232 volunteer attendances; approx. 250 electronic payments; approx. \$6,000 to Russo's for raw fish; GK Benson enthusiastically thanked all of our volunteers; noted no solid complaints about the food (some suggestions); over 40 patrons loved it and asked for the dinners once-per-month (ahhh....NO).
2. Great Easter Week with over 25 Knights attending the Easter Vigil
3. Knights orchestrated the Holy Fire at the beginning in front of the Beaumont church, including set-up, materials, assistance for the priests and deacons, burning of the previous year's blessed oils, and dosing of the embers and clean-up.
4. Events scheduled for the month of April have been cancelled or postponed as appropriate (most volunteers are burned-out from 6 weeks of Fish Frys)
5. The next Hispanic Breakfast will be in May, but the date has not been set
6. The Parish Appreciation Dinner has been set for this Sunday April 12 from noon until (unknown); our Council provide hamburgers and hot dogs
7. Pro-Life Baby set for April 18 in the Parish Hall at Beaumont; Council to help transport gifts to homes (NOTE: In-church announcement at 8:00 a.m. Mass on April
