We participate in Supreme’s “Coats for Kids” program. Each year, we ask the Salem school system, the Salem Boys and Girls Club, and the NH Catholic Charities about their need and also about their excess inventory of winter coats.

The Financial Secretary places the order for winter coats based on the need and the approved budget, which was set in January.

When the coats arrive, we open the cartons and place a “Council 4442” sticker on each coat’s label. The coats are repacked into cartons and then distributed. This label operation may be done in the SJRCS school gym or in a person’s garage. New Hampshire Catholic Charities distributes to their two “young mother” homes Next Generation and Our Place as well as Liberty House (adult sized coats. The Salem Superintendent’s office, as part of “End 68” distributes the coats to the various Salem schools as they request. The Salem Boys and Girls Club gives out coats also. Council members deliver the coat cartons using their car / truck.

The “coats” team can vary from 4 to 12 people.
